**SEARCH WARRANT**

RE: 307 WEST HASTINGS STREET, VANCOUVER, BRITISH COLUMBIA

To: Detective Constable 1093 Ken Hrankowski of the Vancouver Police Department and  
to other peace officers in the Province of British Columbia:

The Government of the United States of America has requested the Government of Canada to  
conduct a search and seizure in Canada. It has made this request pursuant to the *Treaty Between  
the Government of Canada and the Government of the United States of America on Mutual Legal  
Assistance in Criminal Matters*.

I have read the Affidavits of Detective Constable Jennifer Ames of the Vancouver Police  
Department, a competent authority under the *Mutual Legal Assistance in Criminal Matters Act*,  
and am satisfied that there are reasonable grounds to believe the following:

1. the following offences over which the United States of America has jurisdiction have  
been committed: conspiracy to manufacture marijuana, conspiracy to distribute  
marijuana seeds, and conspiracy to engage in money laundering (the "Offences") and that  
Marc Scott Emery, Gregory Keith Williams and Michelle Rainey-Fenkarek are alleged to  
have committed the Offences;
2. that evidence of the commission of the Offences will be found at:  
Marc Emery Direct, 307 West Hastings Street, Vancouver, British Columbia,  
hereinafter called the "Premises"; and
3. that in the circumstances, it would not be appropriate to make an order under subsection  
18(1) of the *Mutual Legal Assistance in Criminal Matters Act*.
